

#### **Access Permits**

A free access permit is required to recreate on Bennett Lumber land. These are available at our Princeton, ID office location. The permit is good for the calendar year of issue and is only valid on Bennett Lumber lands. All hunting is subject to Idaho Fish and Game regulations.

#### **Hunters:**

Keep safely away from houses, other structures, and livestock. Confirm your target! There are many people who utilize Bennett lands for work and recreation.

### **MAMBA Trail Agreement:**

We have partnered with MAMBA to provide an extensive network of single track mountain bike trails on Moscow Mountain. These trails are closed to internal combustion (gas powered) vehicles. Please be respectful of the work and care that has gone into constructing this trail system.

#### **Gate Closures**

Gates are closed seasonally from November to July. Some gates are closed year-round. Do not block any gates.

#### Restricted Areas

Some land owned by Bennett Lumber is closed to the public. These areas are clearly posted.
